(Virginia Revolutionary War Publick Claims)

Hanover Court Thursday 4 Jul 1782 claims against the United States by certificates dated August, 1780 to June 1782:

Elisha White, cert. by Jno. Pierce for 48 days in executing instructions from the executive of this state in procuring supplies for use of army during the siege of York £24; by **Francis Poythress, Sergt.** for diet for 4 men 5s; by Danl. Bates Ensign for diets for a sick soldier 12 days 15 s; by Joseph Harrison Ens. for diet 1 day for 12 men 15s.
