

Will of Robert Kerr Norfolk County, VA 13 Nov 1777

Last Will and Testament of Robert Kerr, Sergeant in the 2nd Company of Charles Harrison Esq.'s Regiment of Artillery, dated 13 Nov 1777, probated February Court 1778.

To my eldest brother, James Kerr, one-half my personal and real estate.

To my other brother, Samuel Kerr, the other half of my estate, real and personal, he paying to each of my next heirs one English guinea each.

My lands being and laying as follows – in West Augusta, Vizt: 600 acres on Hog Run – 600 acres bought of Francis Purley joining Michael Chrisup's land on Bull Runn – and 600 acres on south side of Middle Island and 600 acres on French Creek.

Likewise a Bill of Sale of a house and lot in Kentucky in Herods Town (sic) half acre in lot and ten acres in out lots- etc. Various notes of hand due by (named) – papers above mentioned left in possession of Abraham Lean at mouth of Wheeling in West Augusta, in Virginia.

I do appoint my father, James Kerr, in Bedford Co., Pennsylvania and Thomas Brown Sr. in West Augusta, Virginia my lawful executors, etc.
