



In the name of God Amen I Thomas E. Poythrup of
the County of Cherokee City in the State of Virginia
being of sound mind and disposing memory do
make and ordain this as and for my last will and
testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made
First. It is my will and desire that all my just debts
be paid as speedily after my decease as practicable.
Second. I give to my dear wife Pershba for and during
the period of her natural life all my estate real personal
and mixed of every nature and kind whatsoever.
Second. at the death of my wife I give, bequeath and
devise all my estate real personal and mixed to my brother
Joshua Poythrup, my nephew William P. Poythrup and
my niece Nancy G. Harrison to be equally divided
among them share and share alike to them and their
heirs forever with this condition annexed, they are to
contribute equally to raise the sum of one thousand dol-
-lars for Thomas P. Harrison son of Paxton Harrison
deceased to be paid him at the death of my wife which I
give to him and his heirs forever. I also give the said Thomas
P. Harrison a horse of the value of sixty dollars and my
saddles and bridles to him and his heirs forever, this last
bequest of a horse saddles and bridles I wish him to have
as soon as he completes his education. I also give him
my silver watch at my death, but should he die
before he receives any or all of the legacies herein
given him, then and in that event, I give such as he
may not have received to his sister Rebecca Harrison

except the watch which I give to my friend and neighbor
Thomas H. Willcox. Lastly, I constitute and appoint
my friends George Walker and William P. Poythrup
executors of this my last will and testament, but
only wish George Walker to qualify William P. Poythrup
only to qualify in the event of the death of said Walker or
his refusal to act. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 22nd day of March 1847.

Codicil. I desire that my Executor will immediately
after my decease cause the Harrison family burying
ground on the Pittsman estate to be substantially
enclosed with brick the inclosure to be forty feet square
Given under my hand and seal this 22nd day of
March 1847.

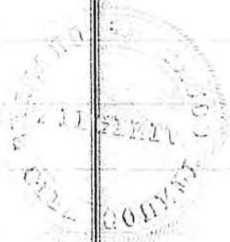
