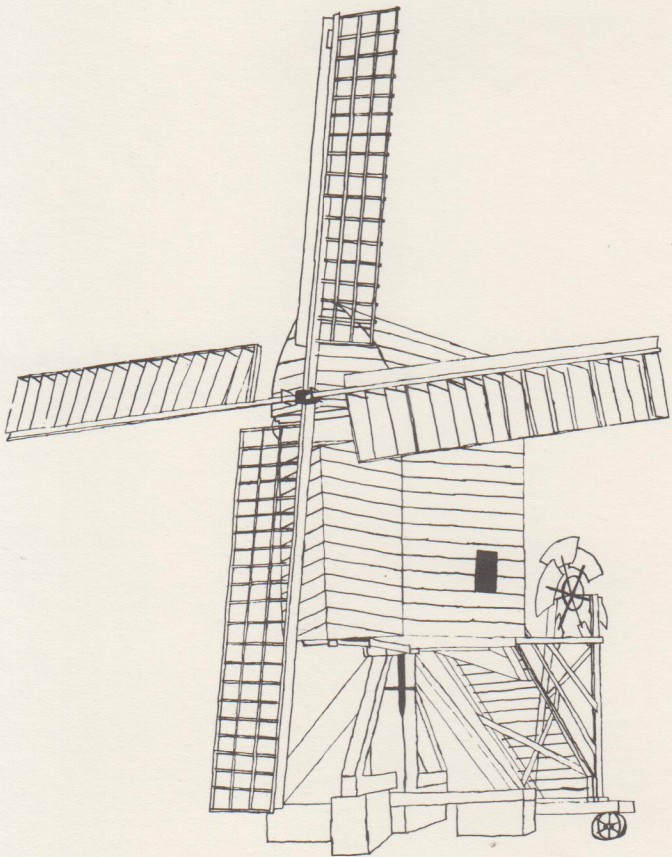




Mist On The Mill
